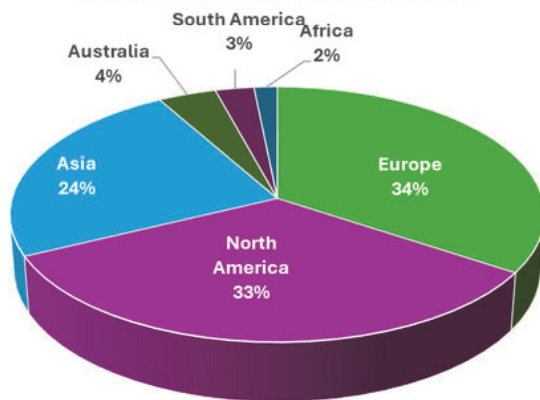

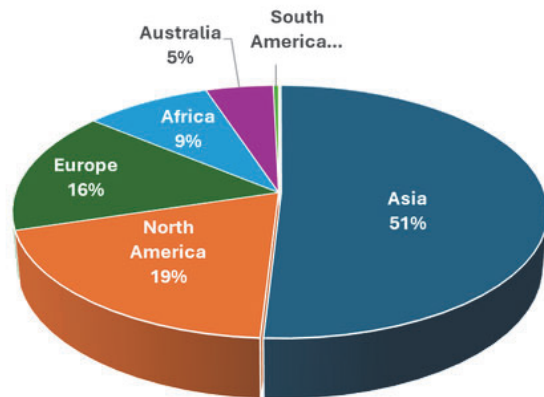

Number of Delegates per Continent



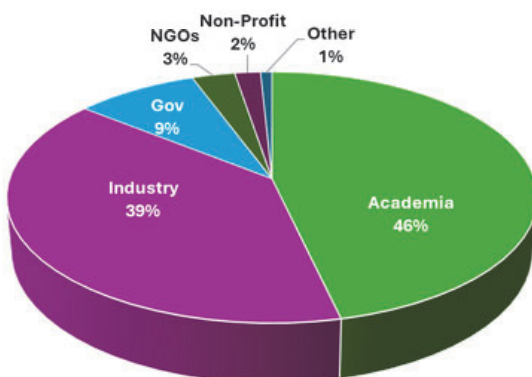

Number of Delegates per Continent



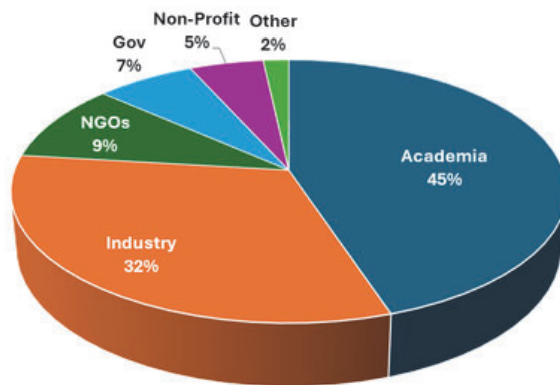

Attendance by Organisation Type

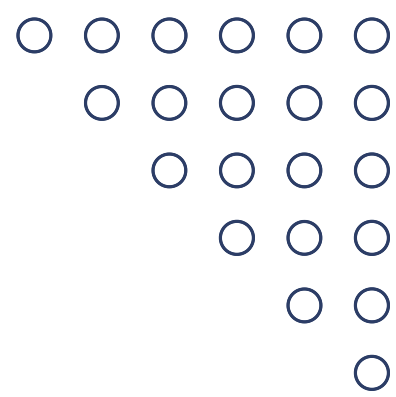

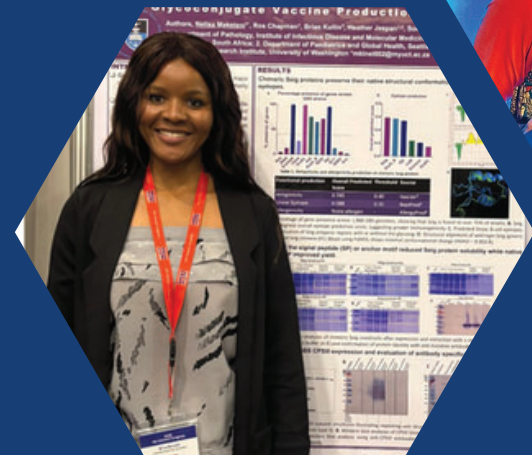

Quarterly (virtual) mini-symposia on vaccine development and innovation topics identified by our industry committee.

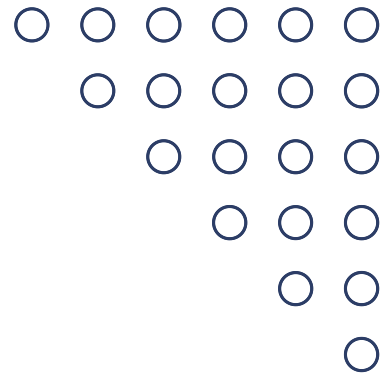

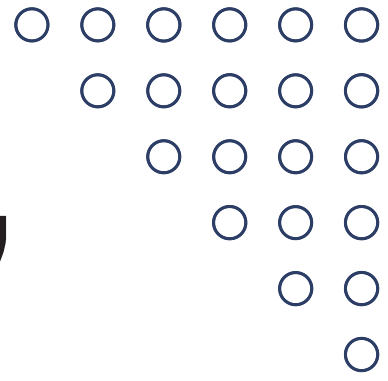

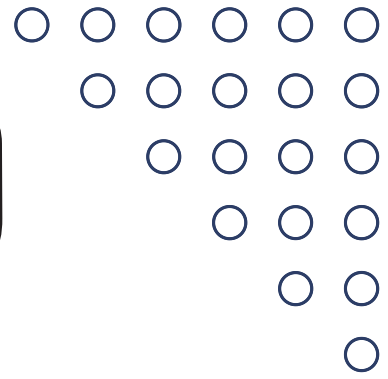

COMMITTEE PURPOSE:

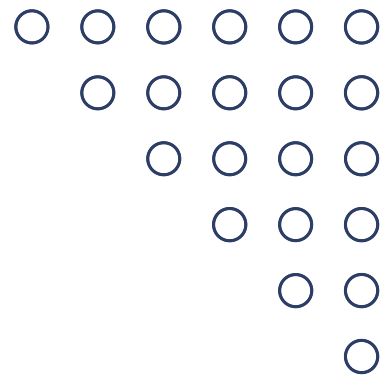
Dedicated to supporting the professional development of Trainees in Vaccinology through conference participation and conference research presentations.
